1.Describe the condition of Italy before unification.

Answer:

- 1. Condition of Italy in the nineteenth century:
- 2. Italy had a long history of political fragmentation. Italians were scattered over various dynastic states as well as multinational Habsburg Empire.
- 3. During the middle of the nineteenth century, Italy was divided into seven states.
- 4. Out of these states only Sardinia-Piedmont was ruled by an Italian princely house.
- 5. The north was under Austrian Habsburgs.
- 6. The center was ruled by the Pope and the southern regions were under the domination of the Bourbon Kings of Spain.
- 7. There was no common language too.

2. The unification of Italy was completed in various stages:

- 1. Sardinia-Piedmont defeated Austria in 1859. Modena, Parma and Tuscany were added t to Piedmont.
- 2. Garibaldi succeeded in South Italy and the Kingdom of the Two Sicilies in 1860 and drove out the Spanish rulers.
- 3. Austria ceded Venetia to Italy in 1866.
- 4. In 1870, Rome was taken over as the French soldiers were withdrawn. Rome was made the capital of Italy.
