Division of Consumers

(i) Herbivores: Plant eaters. Example: goat, deer.

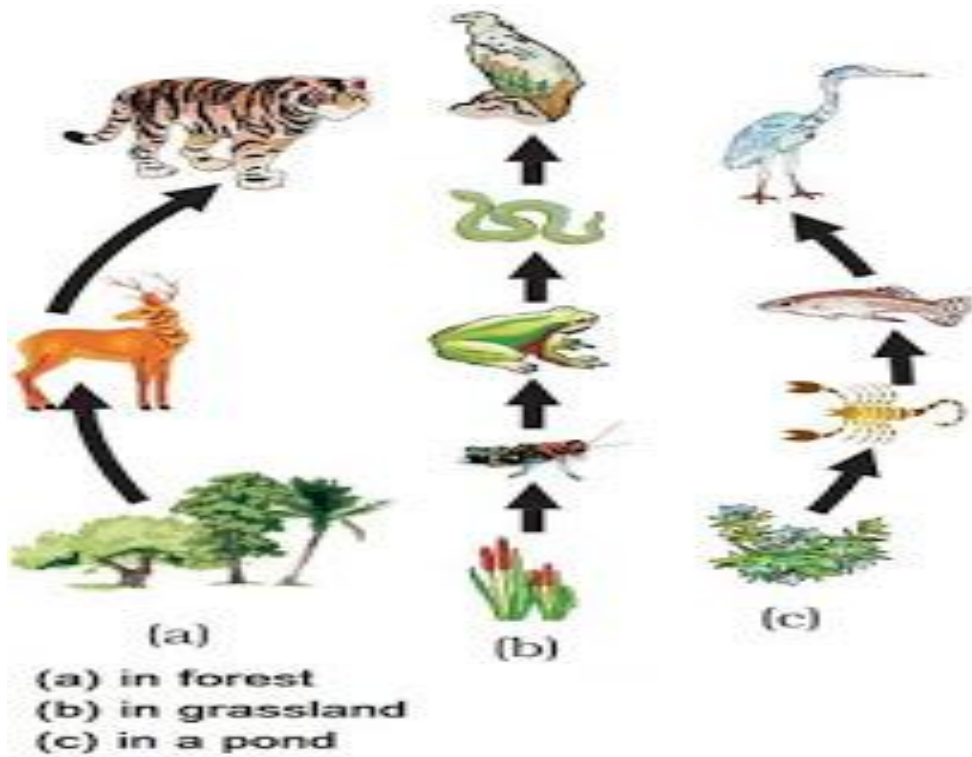
(ii) Carnivores: Flesh eaters. Example: tiger, crocodile.

(iii) Omnivores: Eats both plants and animals. Example: human.

(iv) Parasites: Live on the body of host and take food from it. Example: lice, coccidia.

Decomposers: Include organisms which decompose the dead plants and animals. Example: bacteria, fungi. These help in the replenishment of natural resources.

Food Chain



→ Food chain is a series of organisms in which one organism eats another organism as food.
For example:

- Grass → Deer → Lion

→ In a food chain various steps where transfer of energy takes place is called a trophic level.
