I. Simple Future (Future Indefinite)

☆☆ **I / We + shall + v1.**

We shall win. I shall run.

☆☆ **You / He/ She/ It/ Name/ They + will +v1.**

He will support us. You will sit here.

Negative Sentence:-

☆☆ **Sub.+ shall / will + not + v1.**

He will not enter the house. I shall not cheat her.

Simple Interrogative:-

☆☆ **Shall / Will + Sub. +v1 ?**

Will you follow me? Shall we forgive you?

W-H Interrogative:-

☆☆ **W-H Term + Simple Interrogative**

Where will they stay? When shall I go?

2. Future Imperfect (Continuous)

☆☆ **I / We + shall +be + v1(ing).**

We shall be watching the show.

☆☆ You / He / She / It / Name / They + will +be + v1(ing).

You will be teaching there. He will be waiting.

Negative Sentence:-

☆☆ Sub.+ shall / will +not +be+v1(ing).

Hari will not be reciting poems.

Simple Interrogative:-

☆Shall /will+Sub.+be +v1(ing)?

Will she be watering the flowers?

W-H Interrogative:-

☆☆ W-H Term+ Simple Interrogative

When will he be plucking leaves?

3. Future Perfect

☆☆ I / We + shall have + v3.

We shall have pardoned her.

☆☆You / He / She / It / Name / They +will have +v3.

They will have protected us.

Negative Sentence:-

☆☆Sub.+ shall / will +have +not +v3.

He will not have forgotten me.

Simple Interrogative:-

☆☆ Shall / Will + have +sub.+v3?

Shall have we darkened the picture?

W-H Interrogative:-

☆☆W-H Term + Simple Interrogative

Why will have they surrounded us?

4.Future Perfect Continuous

Time Factor:- (Period of time- for,)

(Point of time—since)

☆☆ I / We + shall have been + v1 (ing).

We shall have been playing tennis for two hours.

☆☆ You / He/ She / It / Name / They + will have been + v1(ing).

Shekhar will have been spinning the top from morning.
