Comparative Degrees :-

##If the sentence is affirmative in Positive degree then its Comparative will be negative.

If the sentence in Comparative Degree is negative then its Positive Degree will be Positive. ...

Pos.-She is as tall as you.[as+D1+as]

Comp.-You are not taller than she.

[D2+than]

Comp.:-She runs faster than you.

Pos.:-You do not run as fast as she.

★★ Interchange of Positive, Comparative and Superlative Degrees:-

** Superlative 1 -----(S1)

[S1]—S.+V.+the+Singular(N)

Sita is the luckiest girl.

Comp.—S.+V.+D2+than+any other + Sing.(N)

Sita is luckier than any other girl.

Pos.—No other +Sing.(N)+V.+as +D1+as+S.

No other girl is as lucky as Sita.

###Superlative 2. (S2)

[S2]—S.+V.+one of the+D3+Plural(N)

America was one of the richest countries.

Comp.—S.+V.+D2+than+most other+ Plural(N)

America was richer than most other countries.

Pos.—Very few+Plu.(N)+Plu(V)+as+D1+as + Sub.

Very few countries were as rich as America.

☆☆Superlative3 { S3 }

(S3) -S.+V.+not+the +D3+of+all+Plu(N)

She is not the cleverest of all girls.

Comp.-S.+V.+not+D2+than+some other +Plu(N)

She is not cleverer than some other girls.

Pos.—Some+Plu(N)+Plural(V)+at least +as+ D1+as+Sub. Some girls are at least as clever as she.
