## The three orders are three social categories:


Christian ,priests, landowning nobles & peasants.

The term 'feudalism' has been used by historians to describe the economic, legal polital and social relationships that existed in Europe in the medieval era.

#### Cathedral - Towns:

The church and Society

From the twelfth century, large churches - called cathedrals - were being built in France. These belonged to the monasteries Cathedrals were built of stone. The area around the cathedrals became more populated and they became centres of pilgrimage

Small towns developed around them. Stained glass was used for windows of the Cathedrals. During the day the sunlight would make the radiant and after Sunset, the light of candles would make them visible to people outside. The stained glass narrated the stories in the Bible through Pictures.
