

CLASS:-11TH, POLITICAL SCIENCE NOTES, CHAPTER:- 5 ,LEGISLATURE

- 1. The Lower House of Parliament is called the Lok Sabha which consists of 545 members.**
- 2. The members of the Lok Sabha are called Members of Parliament(MPs), who are elected on the basis of universal adult franchise. The Lok Sabha is elected for a period of five years.**
- 3. Two Anglo-Indians are nominated by the president if he feels that Anglo-Indians have not been represented suitably in the parliament.**
- 4. The Lok Sabha has a speaker who presides over its session.**
- 5. The Upper House of Parliament is called the Rajya Sabha having 250 members out of which 238 are elected by State Legislative Assemblies and 12 members are nominated by the President.**
- 6. The Legislature is to make laws for its people. A definite procedure is followed in the process of making law.**
- 7. The Vice President of India is the ex-officio Chairperson of the Rajya Sabha.**
- 8. The Lok Sabha enjoys the powers of making laws, to enact Money or non-Money Bills, approves taxation, budgets and annual financial statement, amends constitution, etc.**
