- SHAKAS were kings / people from central Asia origin who established kingdoms in the north-western and western parts of the subcontinent.
- The name of an important textual source of history of south Indian empires that contain poems describing chiefs--TAMIL SANGAM TEXTS.
- The 6th century BCE is regarded as a major turning point in early Indian history due to DEVELOPMENT OF COINAGE GROWING USE OF IRON, EMERGENCE OF EARLY STATES.
- Two reasons for power of Magadh among Mahajanpada----FORTIFIED, CAPITAL CITY, IRON MINES, ELEPHANTS
 ,AGRICULTURE.
- The name by which Ashoka is generally referred to in his INSCRIPTIONS is----PRIYADARSHI.
- The term 'NISHKA' which meant an ornament in the vadic period was used in later times to denote a coin .
- AJATSATRU laid the foundation of the city of PATLIPUTRA.
- Founder of Nanda dynasty was ----MAHAPADMANAND.
- MAHAPADMA NAND is titled as the Second Parshuram.
