REFORM OF THE UN AFTER THE COLD WAR

- 1. Reform of the organisation's structures and processes/- The biggest discussion has been on the functioning of the Security Council & demand for an increase in the UN Security Council's permanent and non-permanent membership.
- 2. Review of the issues that fall within the jurisdiction of the organisation/-some countries and experts want the Organisation to work in peace and 0security micsions, others want to development and humanitarian work

Changes after the Cold War/-

- 1. The Soviet Union has collapsed.
- 2. .The US is the strongest power.
- 3. The relationship between Russia, the successor to the Soviet Union, and the US is much more cooperative.
- 4. China is fast emerging as a great power, and India also is growing rapidly.
- 5. The economies of Asia are growing at an unprecedented rate.
- 6. Many new countries have joined the UN.
- 7. A whole new set of challenges confronts the world (genocide, civil war, terrorism, nuclear proliferation, climate change, environmental degradation, epidemics).
