Arenas of the cold war/-

- 1. The cold war also led to several shooting wars & it did not lead to another world war.
- 2. Korea (1950-53), Berlin (1958 62), the Congo (the early 1960s)
- 3. The other important development was the Non-aligned Movement (NAM) & it means not to join in any group.
- 4. It played a role in reducing cold war conflicts, Which gave the newly independent countries a way of staying out of the alliances.
- 5. Jawaharlal Nehru one of the key leaders of the NAM played a crucial role in mediating between the two Koreas.
- 6. The Cold War did not eliminate rivalries between the two alliances, mutual suspicions led them to arm themselves to prepare for war..
- 7. The US & USSR decided to work together in eliminating certain kinds of nuclear weapons.
- 8. They signed 3 agreements limited test ban treaty (5 aug 1963) nuclear non—proliferation treaty (I July 1968) & the anti ballistic missile treaty.
