- After the 1st World war (1914-18) League of Nations was born. But it could not stop the World War 2.
- In Second World war (1939-45), many more people died and were wounded in this war than ever before, and then UN was founded as a successor to the League of Nations.
- It was established in 24 October 1945 & India signed on 30 October 1945.

UN's objective

- To prevent international conflict.
- To show cooperation among states.
- If it was founded to war in any country then to overcome the limits of enemies.
- To work in Social, Economic development in the world.
- To help in Epidemics & any crisis in the world.
