ODD AND EVEN NUMBERS .

- The numbers that cannot be made into pairs are called ODD NUMBERS.

For example 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9 are odd numbers.

- The numbers that can be made into pairs are called even numbers.

For example 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10 are even numbers.

EVEN NUMBERS always ends with 0, 2, 4, 6, 8

ODD NUMBERS always ends with 1, 3, 5, 7, 9
