An abacus has rods that represent the place of Digit in a given number. The rods are named O, T and H from right to left.

O stand for Ones place.

T stand for Tens place.

H stand for Hundred place.

Example: See the abacus shown here. It has

4 beads in the T rod


2 beads in the O rod
