H stand for Hundred place .

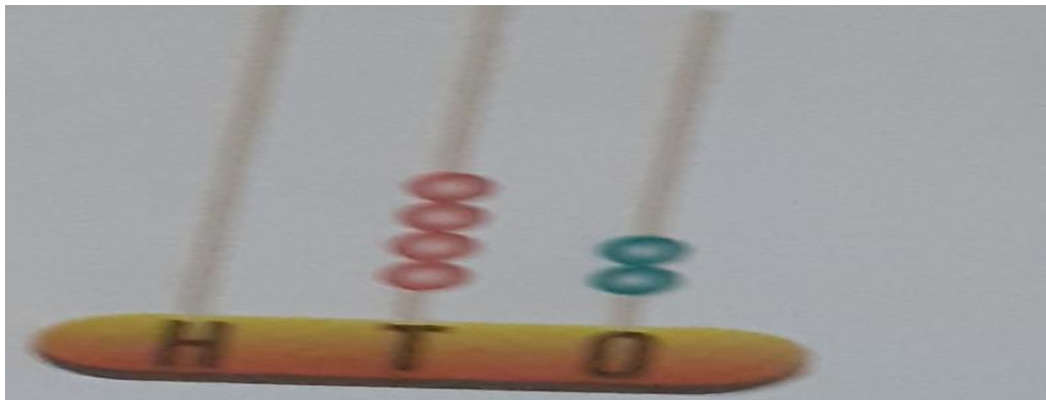
Example :- See the abacus shown here .It has

4 beads in the T rod

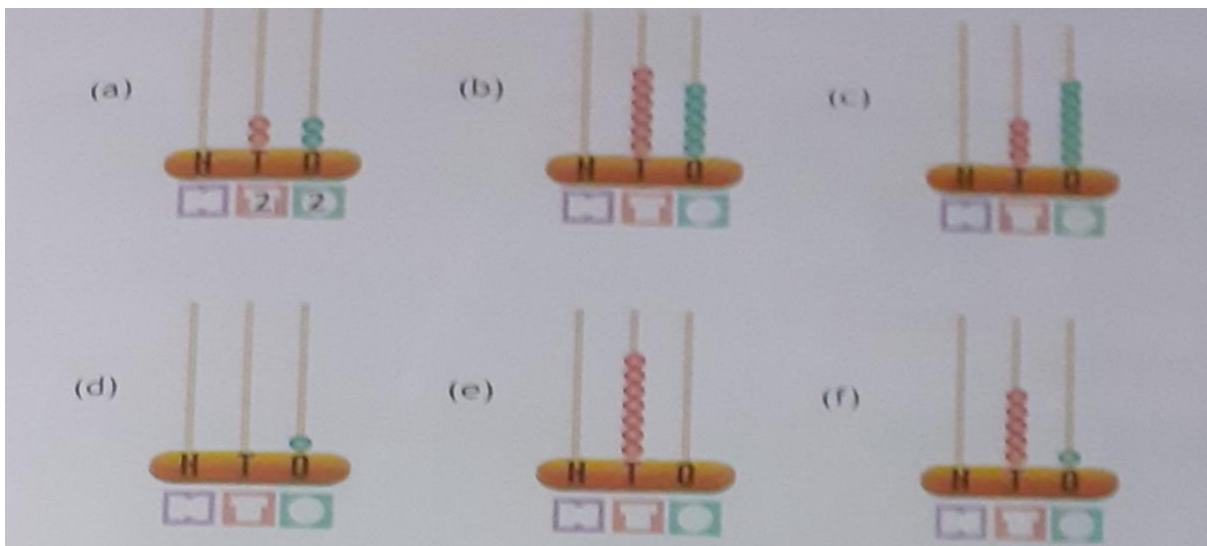
2 beads in the O rod
