How to plant a TREE

STEP 1
Choose a location that will allow the roots to spread and branches to grow freely; away from building foundations, walls, decks, windows and powerlines.

STEP 2
Dig a hole as deep as the root ball and two times as wide.

STEP 3
Remove the tree from its container and place the root ball in the hole, ensuring that the top of the root ball is at soil level.

STEP 4
Fill the hole until the soil line is just at the base of the plant and even with the surrounding soil surface.

STEP 5
Gently tamp the soil around the tree to remove air pockets.

STEP 6
Water the tree well and add a 2-inch (5cm) layer of mulch, such as shredded bark, around the planting area. Continue to water regularly the first three years after planting, until the plant is well established.
