**Nouns**

- Look at the words in each of the columns. What do you notice about the words?

| Column A    | Column B      |
|-------------|---------------|
| boy         | Aarav         |
| girl        | Neha          |
| father      | Vinod         |
| mother      | Ruhi          |
| grandmother | Sudha         |
| grandfather | Raj           |
| cat         | Kitty         |
| house       | Anand Bhawan  |
| hospital    | City Hospital |

- Words in column A refer to persons, places, animals, or things in general.
- They are **naming words**.
- Words in column B refer to *specific* persons, animals, places, or things.
- They begin with a capital letter. For example:  
Neha is not any girl. It is the name of a specific girl.  
So, words in column B are called special naming words.
- Naming words, including special naming words, are also called **nouns**.
- Words in column A are **common nouns**, as they refer to any person, place, or thing.
- Words in column B are **proper nouns**, as they refer to a specific person, place, animal, or thing.
