Apostrophe (')

The apostrophe (') is a small punctuation mark used to show that something belongs to somebody.

(Apostrophe (') एक छोटी विराम चिन्ह है, जो कि किसी चीज को किसी से जोड़ता है।)

For example:- (उदाहरण के लिए)

Tyltyl was Topsy's baby.

In the above sentence, the apostrophe shows that the baby Tyltyl belongs to Topsy.

 - (ii) Raj's bat is heavy. (The bat belongs to Raj.)
