Lesson 6: The Water Cycle

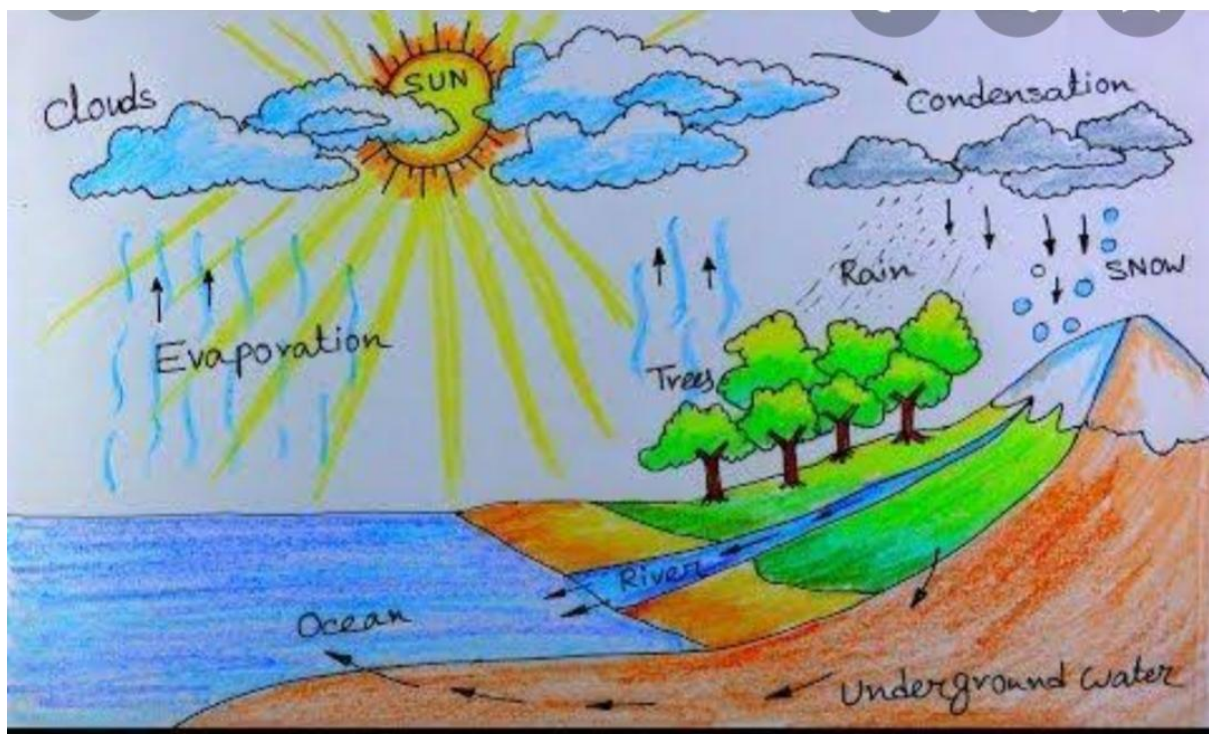
Read the poem and write in note book. In previous online class you knew the summary of this lesson.

This is a question the poet wanted to know when he was young but now he knows.


Do you know?
