 The following pictograph shows the number of boxes of oranges sold by a fruit seller during four weeks of a month.
Read the pictograph and answer the following questions.

Weeks	Number of boxes of oranges sold
1st week	
2nd week	
3d week	
4th week	

1  = 1 box of red

a How many boxes of orange did he sell in the 1st week ?
Answer : 9

b How many boxes of orange did he sell in the 3rd week ?
Answer : 8

c In which two weeks, an equal number of boxes of orange were sold ?
Answer : 2nd and 3rd weeks

d How many total boxes of orange did he sell in four weeks ?
Answer : $9 + 8 + 8 + 6 = 31$

e In which week was the sale of orange minimum ?
Answer : 4th week
