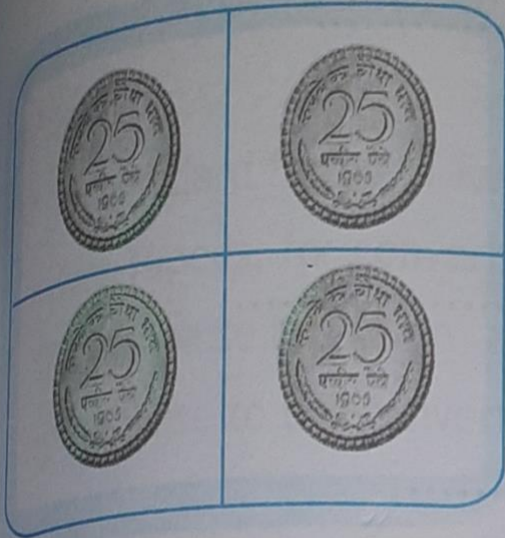

CH- MONEY (₹)

Read and try to understand.

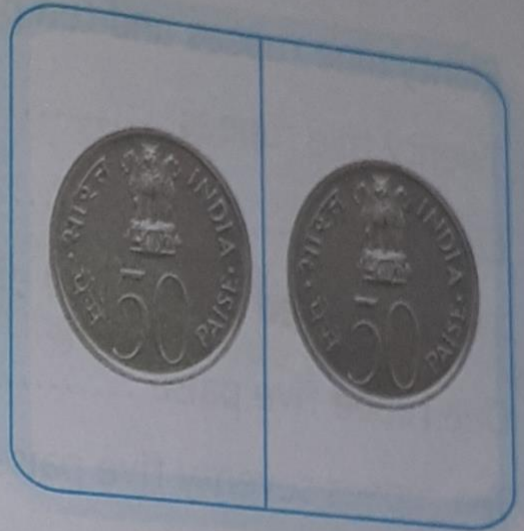
1. Rupee is singular, denoted by Re and Rupees is plural, denoted by ₹ .
2. Paise is denoted by P.
3. We write rupees and paise together separated by a dot or hyphen.
e.g. ₹ 5.10 or ₹ 5-10 (read as five rupees and ten paise)
4. 1 Rupee is equal to 100 paise, symbolically
 $1 ₹ = 100 P$.
5. To convert Rupees to paise, we multiply it by 100
e.g : ₹ 5.25 P = 500 P + 25 P = 525 P
6. To convert paise to rupees, divide by 100.
e.g.: 1005 P = $1005 \div 100 = ₹ 10.05 P$
(To convert paise into rupees, place the dot or decimal point after two numbers from the right)

25 paise is of 100 paise



four 25 paise coins

50 paise is of 100 paise



two 50 paise coins

50 paise and 25 paise make a rupee



One 50 paise and two 25 paise make a rupee.
