Human body is made up of different parts . These parts are called organ . Some of these organs are visible . They are called external organs . The eyes , ears and nose are examples of external organs . Some organs are not visible . They are inside the body . These are called internal organ . The brain , heart , lungs , stomach , liver and kidneys are examples of internal organs .

Let us learn about their structure .

LOCATION AND FUNCTION OF SOME IMPORTANT INTERNAL OF ORGANS

BRAIN :- The Brain is located inside our head . It is protected by a bony called the skull . The brain controls all the functions of our body such as movements , breathing , heartbeat and emotions .

That is why , the brain is also called the master organ of the body .

HEART :- The heart lies beneath the chest slightly towards left . It is protected by the ribcage . The heart is a muscular organ . It has four chambers . The heart pumps blood to all parts of the body . It beats 72 times a minute . You can feel heart beats by placing (keeping) your hand on the chest (slightly towards left side)
