* Adjective of number:- An Adjective of numbers tells us how many persons, animals or things are there.

eg:- Ten Candles, Six pens etc

* Adjective of Degree:- It is help to compare things with each other. They are also called degree of comparison.

Positive degree, comparative degree, superlative degree

To Compare two things we use -er, it is called comparative degree.

eg:- Mishika is taller than Riya.

To compare three or more things and specify the highest degree we use -est. It is called superlative degree

eg:- The giraffe is the tallest animal.
