Points to remember.

Layers of soil

- Top soil- The uppermost layer of soil is called the top soil. It is the most fertile layer because it has humus in it.
- 2. Sub-soil- The layer of soil below the top soil is called the subsoil.
- 3. Bed rock- It is the lowermost layer of the soil which is made up of pieces of rocks.

Types of soil-

- 1. Sandy soil- it is mostly found in deserts and beaches.
- 2. Clayey soil- it is useful for making pots, pitchers, bricks, toys and idols.
- 3. Loamy soil- it is the mixture of both sand and caly. It can hold enough air and water. Therefore it is best for growing crops.
