Dear students, today you have to study about the parts of tooth.

Parts Of Tooth

Dear students, do you know, how many parts of a tooth has? A tooth has two parts and they are known as crown and root.

- 1. Crown: The part of the teeth that we are able to see is the crown.
- 2. Root: The part of the teeth inside the gum that we are not able to see is the root.

Layers of Teeth

A tooth has three main layers:

1. Enamel: Enamel is the outermost covering of the teeth. As it is the hardest material in the human body, it protects the inner parts of the tooth.

- 2. Dentine: Dentine lies under the enamel and forms main part of the teeth. But it is not so hard as the enamel.
- 3. Pulp: The centre of the tooth is called the pulp. It lies inside the dentine. This is soft and consists of blood vessels and nerves. These nerves send signals to our brain and help us to sense touch, pain, heat and cold.

Dear students, I hope you have understood the fact; means whenever you eat different thins, you feel sweet and sour, cold and hot because of pulp of your teeth.
