Dear students, today we are going to study the causes of cavities. We will also come to know the reasons of decaying of our tooth.

Causes Of Cavities And Tooth Decay

 When we eat food, its small particles get stuck in the spaces between the teeth. If we do not brush teeth properly everyday, these particles form a sticky layer called plaque. Bacteria start feeding on this plaque and produce acid. This acid slowly attacks the enamel layer and makes a hole in the tooth. The bacteria then reach the dentine layer and finally to the pulp. When bacteria damage the pulp, they cause pain. This is called tooth decay. Black spots often appear on the decayed tooth. The tooth decay is related to many problems like bad breath, tooth ache, bleeding gum, cavities and indigestion.
