#### ARBOREAL ANIMALS

The animals that live on trees are called arboreal animals .

Monkeys , squirrels and chimpanzee are some of the arboreal animals .

They have the following adaptations :

They have strong legs and arms to provide them support for climbing and moving from one branch to another branch of a tree .

They have a tail for balancing .

Their arms are adapted for holding objects and branches of trees .

#### AERIAL ANIMALS

The animals that can fly are called aerial animals .

Birds and insects are aerial animals .

They are adapted to the environment in the following ways :

Birds have light , hollow and air – filled bones which make their body light .

They have feathers and wings that enable them to fly .

Their body is narrow in the front and at the back and is broad the from middle .
