Dear students, you have come to know that our teeth are very important in our life. Today, you will study about sets of teeth.

Sets Of Teeth

Teeth grow from small patches of tissues covering the bones of the upper and lower jaws. They grow in two sets.

- A new born baby has no teeth because he / she feeds on the mother's milk.
- When the baby is around six months, the first set of teeth starts growing.
- By the age of three years, the child has twenty teeth. These teeth are called milk teeth or temporary teeth.
- Around the age of six years, milk teeth begin to fall off one by one.
- As the milk teeth fall out, a new set of teeth starts growing to take their place.

These teeth are called permanent teeth. They are 32 in number.

Dear students, now it is clear that teeth grow step by step. After falling the milk teeth, the permanent teeth start to grow. But, if you lose either of the permanent teeth, you won't get a new teeth in place of it. So, you should take care of your teeth properly.
