Dear students, you have understood the fact related to the wisdom teeth. Now, you will study about the different kinds of teeth.

Kinds Of Teeth

There are four kinds of teeth:

- 1. Incisors: Incisors are sharp and flat teeth in the front used for biting and cutting the food. They are eight in number.
- 2. Canines: Canines can be seen on each side of the incisors. They are pointed and sharp and used for tearing the food. They are four in number.
- 3. Premolars: Premolars are broad teeth located next to the canines. They are eight in number. Their function is to crush and crack the

- food into smaller pieces. They are also called cracking teeth.
- 4. Molars: Molars are located next to premolars and are broader than premolars. They are twelve in number. They grind and chew the food. They are also called grinding teeth. The last molars are also called wisdom teeth.

Dear students, all the teeth are divided into two parts; as the first half of each kind is in the upper jaw and the second half is in the lower jaw. Can you guess, which kind of teeth are more important in your life?
