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### Past Continuous Tense

We use the **past continuous tense** to talk about actions that were continuing in the past. The form of the past continuous tense is *was/were + verb+ing*. We use *was* with singular subjects and *were* with plural subjects. For example:

*I was travelling at that time.*  
*The cat was sleeping on the sofa.*  
*Some monkeys were teasing the dog.*
