1. Points to write and remember.

- Force of friction develops when an object touches or rubs against a surface .
- Friction either slows down or completely stops the object from moving .
- If there is no friction , then things will not stop moving . But , if there is too much of friction, things will not move at all .
- Friction is useful in many ways .
 - a. it prevents us from slipping while walking .
 - b. It helps us to hold many things .

- Friction is also harmful in many ways .
