Lesson 1:- Chuskit Goes To School

Grammar: Subject-verb Agreement

- The verb in a sentence must agree with its subject in number.
- If the subject is singular, the verb also must be in singular. Ex:-

The road is too rough and uneven.

The roads are too rough and uneven.

In the first sentence, the subject, the road, is singular. Therefore, the verb used is singular- is.

In the second sentence, the subject, the roads, is plural. Therefore, the verb used is also plural- are.

- We must identify whether the subject of a sentence is singular or plural so that we can use the correct form of a verb.
- When two singular subjects are joined by the conjunction(and), they form a plural subject; so a plural verb is needed. Ex:-

Chuskit and Stanbdo now go to school together.

• When a phrase such as neither...., either...., or one of the.... forms of the subject, the subject is singular, so a singular verb is used. Ex-

One of the teachers helps Chuskit with math work.

- When a singular subject is followed by a plural phrase, it takes a singular verb. Ex: Abdul along with his friends is clearing the path along the stream.
- When a plural subject is followed by a singular phrase, it takes a plural verb. Ex: The pebbles on the path were slippery.
- When two singular subjects are joined by conjunction or/ either.....or/ neither..... nor, they form a singular subject; so a singular verb is needed. Ex-

Either Aba - ley or Ama - ley is providing snacks to the children.

Some nouns look plural but are actually singular.
 These are names of subject, words, such as news and measles, titles of books and movies that end in-s. Ex-

Physics is my favourite subject.

The news of landslides is alarming.

Bedtime Stories is my favourite book.

 A collective Noun is considered as one unit, so it takes a singular verb. Ex Our team has won the match.

A herd of cows is crossing the road.
