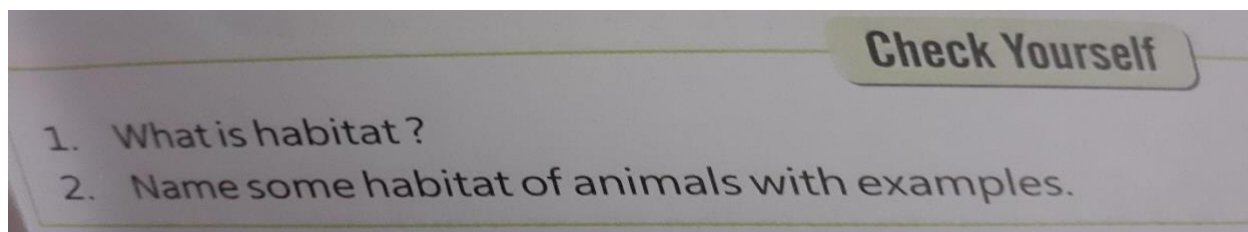

Ans 1 : Rabbits are Herbivores...

This means that they rely on a strict plant-based diet. This is because they need a lot of fiber in their diet.

Ans 2 : A bear is an omnivore because it eats both Plants and animals .

Ans 3 : Scavengers feed on the dead bodies and thus those who are dependent on decaying smelly matter. Some of the popular examples of decomposers are vultures, crows, hyenas, etc.

Ans 4 : Frog and Eater are two examples of insectivorous .

Ans 5 : The movement of large group of animals from one place to another at a particular time

known as **migration** . They migrate to avoid some unfavourable conditions for in search of food or to have safe place for breeding .

Ans 1: Terrestrial animals are animals that live entirely on land (e.g., cats, ants, spiders).

Ans 2 : Kiwi and Ostrich are birds but they cannot fly .

Ans 3 : Birds are warm-blooded, egg-laying animals that have a backbone. They are different from mammals because they lay hard-shelled eggs and have feathers. A bird has four limbs—two that are wings—along with a beak and no teeth.

Ans 4 : Mammals have hair or fur; are warm blooded ; most are born alive; the young are fed milk produced by the mother's mammary glands; and they have a more complex brain than other animals .
