known as migration. They migrate to avoid some unfavourable conditions for in search of food or to have safe place for breeding.

Ans 1: Terrestrial animals are animals that live entirely on land (e.g., cats, ants, spiders).

Ans 2: Kiwi and Ostrich are birds but they cannot fly.

Ans 3: Birds are warm-blooded, egg-laying animals that have a backbone. They are different from mammals because they lay hard-shelled eggs and have feathers. A bird has four limbs—two that are wings—along with a beak and no teeth.

Ans 4: Mammals have hair or fur; are warm blooded; most are born alive; the young are fed milk produced by the mother's mammary glands; and they have a more complex brain than other animals.
