

Metaphor

- A **metaphor** is a figure of speech in which something is referred to as something else to show a similarity.
- The poet calls parts of clouds *bulging sails*. This is a metaphor.
- The clouds have been compared to sails.
- Another example of metaphor is 'The baby is a delicate flower,' which means the baby is delicate like a flower.
