* If the subject is plural, a plural helping verb is used.

eg:- The boys are making a lot of noise

* If the subject is singular, a singular helping verb is used.

eg:- Rama is quiet boy.

* For more than one subject, joined with and, a plural helping verb is required.

eg:- Meenu and Riya are going to school.

* For singular subjects , the main verb becomes singular.

eg:- He plays in the park.

* for Plural subjects, the main verb becomes plural.

eg:- They play in the park.
