Ch 5:- Adjectives

Adjectives are those words that give colour, shape, size, sound and felling to the nouns.

eg:- A sharp knife, A dusty road, A soft toy

Here sharp, dusty, soft are adjective that describes the noun knife, road and toy.

Kind of adjective:-

Adjective of quantity:- tell us about the quantity of nouns.

eg:- some, few, much, less etc

Adjective of quality:- tell us about the quality of nouns.

eg:- Honest, nice, tasty, easy, etc

Adjective of Numbers:- tell us about the number of the nouns.

eg:- three, four, six etc

Demonstrative adjective are used to point out at a particular person or thing.

eg:- these boys, those girl, this pen, etc

Note:- Demonstrative adjective is placed before the noun.

Interrogative Adjective are used to ask questions.

eg:- which boy is out of the class?

Note:- an interrogative adjective is placed before the noun.

Possessive Nouns shows belongingness of a particular noun.

eg:- My parents, thier house, his bicycle

Note:- a possessive adjective is placed before a noun.
