
Today's Topic: Mountains

Mountains:

Mountains are usually very cold and windy. In some areas, snowfall takes place in winters. Conifers are trees that are mostly found in mountainous regions.



Conifers are normally cone shaped and have sloping branches. They do not have leaves but have needles, which help rainwater and snow slide off easily.



Animals living in the mountain regions are also adapted to cold conditions. They have thick skin or fur to protect them from the cold. Some animals that live on the mountains have strong hooves for running up the rocky slopes of mountains.
