**TOPIC: LIFE OF THE PEOPLE** 

**Economic activity and occupation.** 

The cities were busy with activities. Craft seems to have been the main occupation of the people.

Pottery making was a specialised skill.

Metal work watch one more highly advanced craft.

Copper and bronze gear used to make tools, weapons, ornaments and vessels.

Making of gold and silver jewellery also seems to have been a highly admired craft .

Bead making vase and other specialised craft.

Beads were made from a wide variety of materials – stones like carnelian, jasper, crystal; metals like copper, bronze and gold; shells and baked, clay or Terracotta.

Sales are another special contribution of this civilization .

Terracotta was a reddish brown clay backed for making pots and toys. Faience is a man made material which was glazed to give shiney glass surfaces.

They usually had animal cravings on them . probably they were used by merchants and traders to stomp their goods .

**Cotton weaving was also practiced.** 

Spindle whorls to spin thread have been found in some of the Harappan sites.

That accounts for the excellence of the craftsmanship.
