### Newspaper Article

Read the news article in the Warm up section again. Notice that a news article has some of these common elements.

A catchy headline grabs the attention of the reader and creates curiosity.

A byline which indicates the writer's name. The byline usually appears after the headline but before the body.

Lead in- This is the first paragraph. It gives the most important information and provides detailed preview of the entire story. It also includes basic facts and figures.

The story - The next few paragraphs contain a well-written story supported by well-researched facts and have quotes from various sources. However, not too

many quotes are included.

The paragraphs are not long. Each one can be three to four sentences each.

The article should not have the writer's opinion.
