THE SENTENCE

Read the following groups of words-

An aeroplane flies in the air.
 The sun rises in the east.
 February is the shortest month of the year.

Each of these groups of words makes complete sense.

A group of words that makes complete sense is called a Sentence.

Kinds of Sentences

- Sentences can do four kinds of things. A sentence can-
- (1) Make a statement as,The earth moves round the sun.(Affirmative)He never tells a lie. (Negative)

A sentence that states or declares something is called an A ssertive or Declarative Sentence.

(2) Ask a question ; as,What is the matter?Who does not love his country ?

<u>A sentence that asks a question is called an Interrogative Sentence.</u>

3 Express some command, request, entreaty or wish as, Never surrender. (Command) Lend me your book, please. (Request) Help me, O God. (Entreaty) God save the Queen. (Wish)

A sentence that expressess a command, a request, an entreaty or a desire is called an Imperative Sentence.
