Articles

Articles are words that tell us whether we are referring to a particular person or thing or a general one

The articles a and an are called indefinite articles and are used for non-specific nouns.

A and an are used with singular, countable nouns.

An is generally placed before words that begin with a vowel sound. For example: an hour, an umbrella

A is placed before words that begin with a consonant sound. For example: a uniform, a table

The article the is called a definite article and is used for a particular or specific noun. For example:

We will visit the museum next week.

The is used with singular as well as plural nouns.
