(i) to denote duty or obligation; as,

We should obey our elders.

She should control her temper.

(ii) possibility, etc; as,

to denote a condition, supposition,

If it should rain, we shall have a holiday.

If he should come, ask him to wait.

(ii) to indicate a concession; as,

We will not believe it, though an angel should come from heaven and say it.

(iii) when giving or asking for advice; as,

You should not play with fire.
