MEASUREMENT:

Measurement is an important part of our daily life. We need to know the length of cloth required to make curtains, the time it takes to reach school, the amount of fuel needed to fill a vehicle's petrol tank and so on. When we say we measure these things, what we actually do is compare what we do not know (for example, the length of the curtain) to what we already know (Length marked on a scale or measuring tape).
