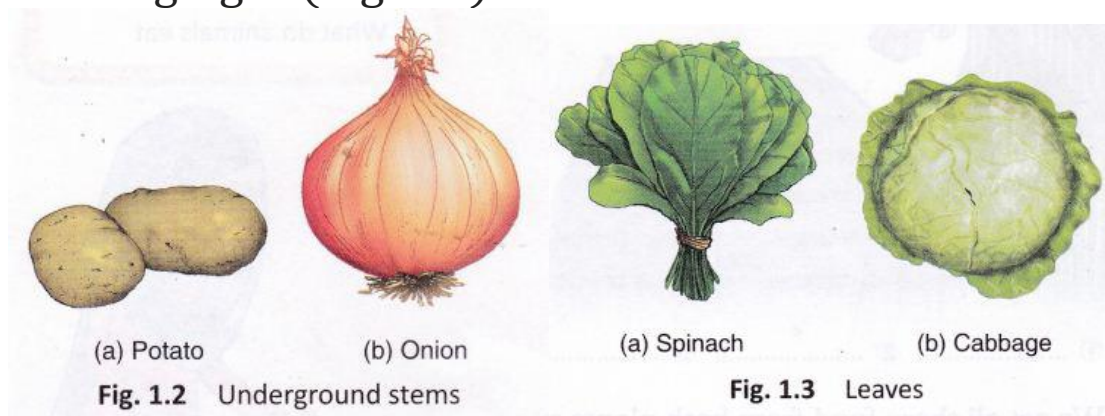

► Food : Where does it Come from EXERCISE : NCERT

- Stems of certain plants are eaten. For example, the stem of sugarcane plant is eaten and is also used to make sugar. The stem and flower of the banana plant is cooked and eaten in different parts of India. Certain plants have underground stems that we eat. Examples: potato, onion, garlic, and ginger (Fig. 1.2).



- Flowers of certain plants like cauliflower, broccoli, and banana are also eaten (Fig. 1.4).
