Ch5-Panchayati Raj System(Civics)

Panchayati Raj:- an organisation that governs at the village levels three tier system consisting of Gram Panchayat, Panchayat Samiti and Zila Parishad.

Grass root level:- basic level; at the level of rural & agricultural population.

Committee:- a group of people who work to find out & suggest ways to counter any issue or resolve any problem with a view to raise the efficiency.

Amenities:-facilities that make a place comfortable to live in.

Grant:-financial assistance that is not repaid.

Grant-in-aid: single sum of money paid from public fund by the central government (or by a private organization) as aid.

Rajasthan was the first state to adopt the Panchayati Raj system in India, while other states followed later. On. This system is based on the 73rd Constitutional Amendment Act, which came into force on 24th April, 1993.It works at three level-Gram Panchayat at village level, the Panchayat Samiti at block level and the zila Parishad at the district level.
