**Ch5-Panchayati Raj System(Civics)**

**Panchayati Raj:- an organisation that governs at the village levels three tier system consisting of Gram Panchayat, Panchayat Samiti and Zila Parishad.**

**Grass root level:- basic level; at the level of rural & agricultural population.**

**Committee:- a group of people who work to find out & suggest ways to counter any issue or resolve any problem with a view to raise the efficiency.**

**Amenities:-facilities that make a place comfortable to live in.**

**Grant:-financial assistance that is not repaid.**

**Grant-in-aid :- single sum of money paid from public fund by the central government (or by a private organization) as aid.**

**Rajasthan was the first state to adopt the Panchayati Raj system in India, while other states followed later. On. This system is based on the 73<sup>rd</sup> Constitutional Amendment Act, which came into force on 24<sup>th</sup> April, 1993.It works at three level-Gram Panchayat at village level, the Panchayat Samiti at block level and the zila Parishad at the district level.**
