Respond to the Mongols attack during the period of Alauddin Khalji and Muhammad Tughlaq.

Alauddin Khalji

- Delhi was attack twice in 1299 1300 and 1302 – 1303.
- To tackle this, he raised large standing Army .
- Constructed new Garrison town named Siri.

- Tax in form of produce from Ganga -Yamuna doab was collected to feed soldiers.
- Tax was fixed at 50% of peasant's yield.

Muhammad Tughlaq

- Delhi was attacked under him also, Mongols Army was defeated.
- He also raised a large standing Army.
- No Garrison towns was constructed, rather older Garrison where emptied and residents were moved to the new capital of Daulatabad in south.
- Produce from the same area was collected as tax to feed army and additional tax was imposed this led to a famine.
