- **Arch - a semi-circular architectural design brought to India by the Turks.**
- **Chahalgani – the group of forty Turkish nobles who helped iltutmish to rule the Delhi sultanate.**
- **Delhi sultanate – rule by the Delhi Sultan from 1200 AD to 1526 AD.**
- **Indo – Islamic culture – interaction of Indian culture with Islamic culture that led to the rise of newer and richer culture.**
- **Blood and iron policy – very strict and harsh policy of balban to bring order and suppress all oppositions.**

- **Chehra - a detailed description of each soldier maintained during the reign of Alauddin Khalji.**
- **Iqtas – land grants given to the nobles and officers in lieu of the salary .**
- **Jaziya - tax imposed on non Muslim in a Muslim state.**
