Past perfect tense:

Past perfect tense is used:

 To describe an action that was completed before another action took place.

Example: The girls had slept before grandma returned from the market.

 As the past form of present perfect, especially in indirect speech.

Example:Rita said," I have prepared pudding." (direct speech)

Rita said that she had prepared pudding.(indirect speech)

• To report a completed action in past

Example: Ajay told me that he had won a prize.

FORMS OF PAST PERFECT TENSE:

I/we/you/he/she/it/they + had+ v 3

For example: I had taken the newspaper.

In negative sentence: subject+ had + not + v3

In interrogative sentence:
Had + subject +V3 +?
For example: Had I spoken to you
