PAST PERFECT CONTINUOUS TENSE:

- The past perfect continuous tense is used:
- To show an action that had been going on before another past action.

Example: The girl had been trying to make the model of volcano before the teacher helped her.

To show an action that was recently completed.

Example: Tendulkar had been playing for two hours before he was run out.

FORMS OF PAST PERFECT CONTINUOUS TENSE

I/we/you/he/she/it/they. + had + been +v4

For example: She had been meeting all the people before she contested the election.

In negative sentence:

Subject + had + not + been +v 4

For example: He had not been keeping well since a year.

In interrogative sentence:

Had +subject+ been + V4

For example: Had you been playing in the ground before it started raining?
