SUBJECT AND PREDICATE

Every sentence consists of two parts

1 The person or thing we speak about.

2 What we speak about that person or thing.

Consider the following sentence.

Peter is an intelligent boy.

In this sentence,

- (i) we speak about Peter, and
- (ii) what we say about him is that he is an intelligent boy

The name of the person or thing we speak about is called the Subject.

What we say about the subject is called the predicate
